With his own insightful analysis as well as primary sources, His Holiness charts the evolution of the two main Christological traditions known as the Antiochene and Alexandrian Schools. This development ultimately led to the Council of Chalcedon and the division of Orthodoxy into the Greater and Lesser Orthodox families (in the latter of which falls the Armenian Church). The Council had a huge impact on Armenian Church history particularly in the 5th through 12th centuries but well into the present. This volume is a 2006 reprint of the 1964 classic study of the same name and is one in the Karekin I Series which makes available the theological work of the late Catholicos.


