

Sunday School Craft

Away in a "Folding" Manger

SCRIPTURE:

Luke 2:12

And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger."



MATERIALS:

- Template (*to follow*)
- Optional: Straw or shredded paper, to use as "hay"

To Make Baby Jesus:

- Cookies (like a "Vienna Finger" or Keebler "E.L. Fudge Sandwich" or Keebler "Fudge Sticks")
- Gauze or Toilet Paper

PREPARATION:

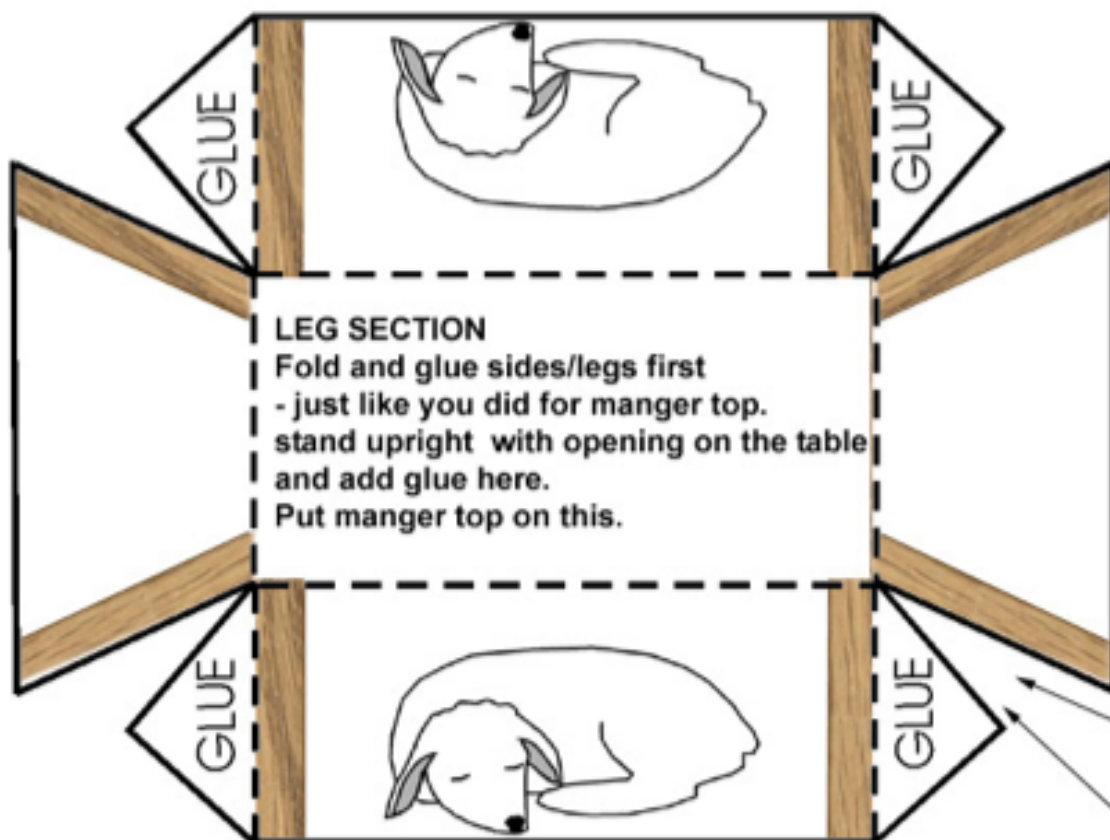
- Print out Template (*to follow*) in color, if possible - 1 copy for each student
- Carefully cut Toilet Paper into squares

DIRECTIONS:

1. Give each student a copy of the Template, (*to follow*). Follow directions as printed on template.
2. *Optional:* Place straw or shredded paper in bottom of manger.
3. **MAKE BABY JESUS:** Take a cookie (*see recommended options below*) and a small piece of gauze or 1-square of toilet paper. Wrap the baby! Place inside the manger on top of the straw.

Easy Cutting instructions

To cut each inside corner, put your scissors in to cut along one line until you reach the pointy corner.
 PULL OUT OUR SCISSORS and put them back to cut along the other edge until you get to the pointy corner.
 DO NOT TRY TO TURN YOUR SCISSORS IN THE POINTY CORNER.
