

Personal Identity Assignment

Goal: Before we begin learning from one another, it's important to reflect on who we are. This activity will encourage you to examine: What is your personal identity? You'll accomplish this by creating an image board of your identity and answering a few questions!

Task: Create a collage that uses images, words, symbols, and phrases that showcase your self-pride, traits, cultural heritage, your family history, and anything you think influences your personal identity. You should have at least 10 different items in your collage.

How: How you create your image board is up to you! It can be done on a google doc., slideshow, jamboard, online poster creator (such as canva), etc. Just be sure you have a way to share the finished product with me in the end (I'll be sure to share mine with all of you!)

After you create your image board answer these questions:

1. Which part(s) of your identity do you think about the most often? Why is that?

2. Which part(s) of your identity do you think about the least often? What makes it less relevant to your day-to-day life?

3. Which part(s) of your identity would you like to explore and learn more about?

4. Which part(s) of your identity most impacts how you perceive yourself? Which part(s) of your identity most impacts how you believe other people perceive you? Explain why you feel this way.
